Click on the **PLAYLISTS** tab **A**





Click on **CREATE A NEW PLAYLIST** **B**


Chapters are film segments created by you and containing your favourite parts of a film.

## CREATING A CHAPTER


On a film page, click on the [Create a chapter](#) icon **A**

You will be redirected to a new screen

Locate the segment you want by watching the film and noting the beginning and end times on the video progress bar **B**

## CHAPTERS

Chapters are film segments created by you and containing your favourite parts of a film.

## CREATING A CHAPTER (CONTINUED)

Move the cursor along the timeline **D** to mark the start and end points of your segment

OR

Manually enter the **Start** and **End** times **E**



Enter a title in the chapter **Title** box **F**

Enter a description of the segment in the chapter **Description** box **G**

Click on the **Preview** button **H** to verify the segment

Click on the **Save** button **I**

You are automatically redirected to the **My Chapters** section of your account, where you can add the chapter to a playlist **J**


